What's involved?

A pre-built scenario with role play activity designed to increase awareness of cyber security threats.

Participants get the chance to question the staff of a fictitious company that has experienced a cyber-attack.

The aim is to find out how the attack began and what happened next.

What's involved?



Option one:

We provide the Whodunnit activity kit for you to run the exercises yourself. This includes:

- a cyber-attack scenario
- character cards for the role play
- a facilitator's guide.



Option two;

We will provide the Whodunnit activity kit and facilitate the exercise for you.

You will need 2 hours to run the sessions.





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Tabletop exercises

Scenario activities with a range of cyber issues based on real-life events, for you and your teams to discuss and design cyber incident response strategies.



Option one:

Option two:

We provide the activity kit and facilitate the exercises for you, so staff can take part.

You will need 2 hours to run the sessions.





Exercise levels

Choose the exercise level to suit your needs:

Bronze



For cyber security beginners, events based around individuals losing information or sending information to the wrong place.

Silver



For people who would like to practice what they already know. For example, how to handle incoming threats via phone, text, email and unexpected visitors.

Gold



For people who are experienced and require stretch training opportunities. For example, how to handle cyber supply chain compromise.
